Master classes are shared individual lessons within an hour-long class. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend classes with their children. All levels from pre-"twinklers" to advanced players. Please come prepared to play a polished piece from the Suzuki repertoire. Pre-twinklers should prepare twinkle rhythms on open strings.

GUITAR CAMP

Youth – Intro to Folk Guitar

This course will introduce tuning, basic technique (left hand fingering and right hand positioning and use), using the flat pick, note reading, melody playing, chord shaping, tablature, playing with other musicians, and the care and feeding of your guitar. Songs chosen by class consensus.

Louise Stuppard Core Strings

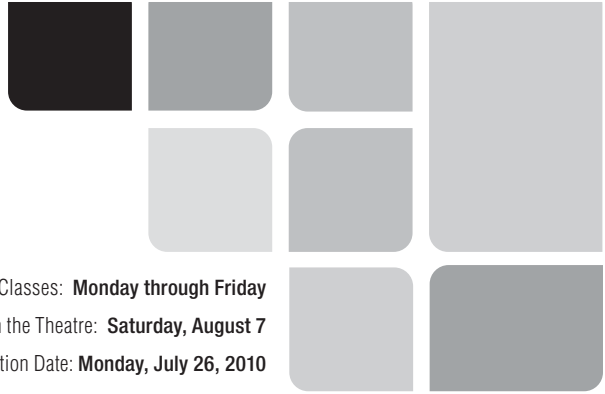
